

Flood risk management

Charlton drop-in session on Monday, 26 September 2011

The Environment Agency are holding a drop-in session for anyone to ask questions about the Charlton flood risk management scheme. This will be on Monday, 26 September at The Old Schoolroom, Ryden Lane, Charlton. The session will be informal, so please drop in to talk to our staff between 4:30pm and 8:00pm.

The Environment Agency is currently developing a flood risk management scheme for Charlton. Unfortunately previous studies have shown that a community wide scheme cannot be economically justified for the village. As an alternative we are now looking at providing individual property level flood protection. We have already written to the owners of properties that are at risk of flooding and could benefit from individual property protection.

We are also planning to work with local land owners to reduce surface water runoff through land management practices. At the drop-in we can discuss riparian owners responsibilities for keeping Merry Brook clear.
